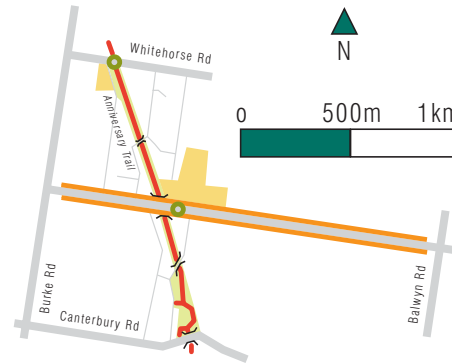
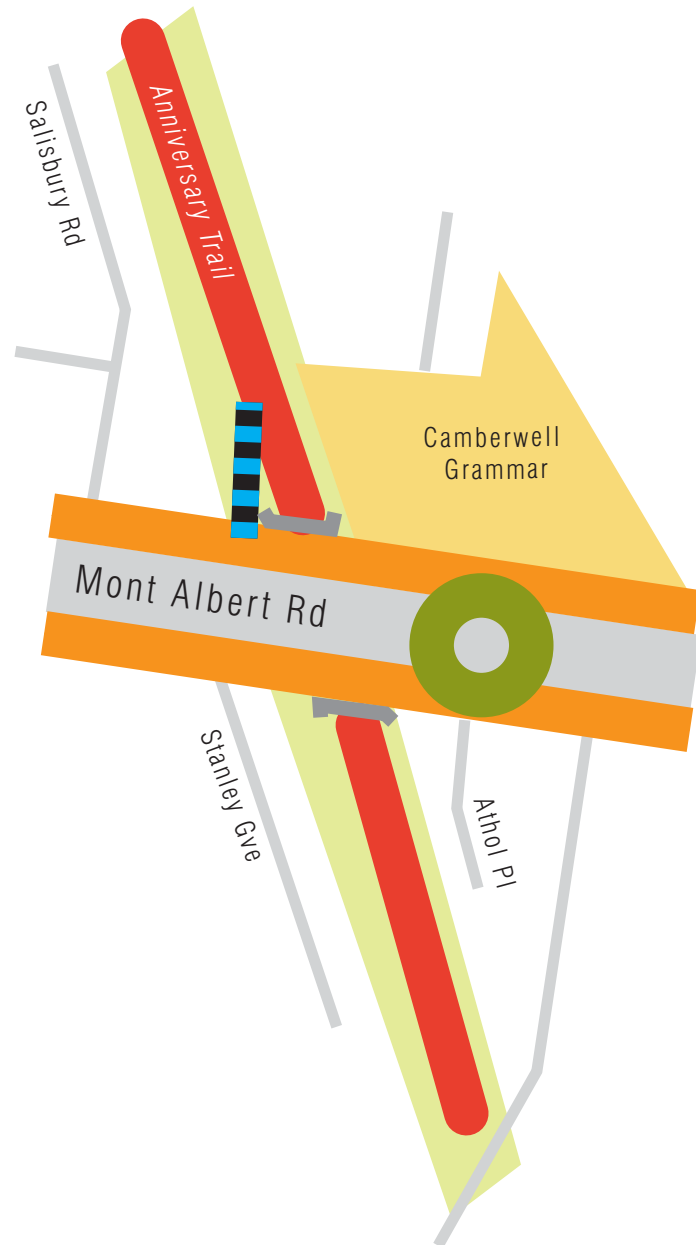



Anniversary Trail link to Mont Albert Rd



 A link is needed to join the Anniversary trail to Mont Albert Rd. Currently you must travel in 1km to either Whitehorse or Canterbury Rd to get onto the Trail. The long distance between these two also constitutes a safety/security risk to the many walkers whom frequent this stretch. Having this link would also help to alleviate road traffic to the trail's adjoining schools during peak hour. The specified location (North-West of bridge) would allow connection to the M.A. Rd EBL and Ped lights. There is ample landscape available here to do so. Only a cyclone fence currently blocks the street frontage. A ramp/path would need to be built.
