

Protocols for the BUG Wiki Web Site
March 2008 Rev 1

In general the BUG welcomes applications for accreditation as an author/editor on the web site. We aim to provide the opportunity for as many cyclists and cycling advocates as possible to publicise their knowledge and ideas, so long as these are compatible with the aims of the BUG. These are to promote the development of a safe and practical environment for utility and recreational cyclists in the City of Boroondara and to encourage cycling generally.

In order to obtain accreditation to author/edit material on the BUG web site applicants must fulfil the following requirements:

1. Be a paid up member of the BUG
2. Have attended at least 3 BUG meetings in the last 12 months

Applications will be considered at the next BUG meeting. For an application to be accepted at least four members must be present at the meeting and a consensus must be reached.

All authors/editors need to be aware that new material added to the site, and alterations to the site, will be regularly monitored. Their material may be further edited for purposes of correction or clarification, or even removed if it is considered unhelpful to the aim of the BUG.

The committee reserves the right to block accreditation if an author/editor is seen to be using the site for purposes unrelated to, or in conflict with, those of the BUG, or if any conflict of interest becomes apparent.
