

Cycling facilities in Boroondara

Boroondara is slowly building a cycling-friendly network of paths to help get you from A to B safely. Whilst the Principle Bicycle Network (PBN) has seen the application of many on-road lanes, there is also the major off-road paths: Gardiners Creek trail, Anniversary trail and the Yarra trail. Sometimes however your 'A' nor 'B' will be on or near these. For this reason we have compiled a series of 'Suggested alternate/practical routes'. Chosen for directness/activity centres, safety (to you *and* others), and to help avoid or at least ease the pain of Boroondara's abundant hills!
